## **GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF HUNTER'S INSURANCE CLAIMS**

## Terms which apply in the case of a claim

- 1. The Insured is obliged to inform the Company in writing within 3 days of any case of injury which could give rise to a claim on the basis of the Policy and, in the case of hospitalisation, before discharge. In addition, the Insured is obliged to provide full details of the event within twenty one days. In the case of death disclosure must be immediate. In the case of death of the Hunting Dog, the event must be reported to the Police. The Insured will bear the cost of all reports, certificates and information required and specified by the Company. In relation to any claim, the Insured will undergo a medical examination whenever required at the Company's expense. In the case of death where there is reasonable doubt as to the cause of death, a qualified doctor appointed by the Company will carry out an autopsy.
- 2. In the case where the circumstances may result in a claim in accordance with the Policy, the Insured must inform the Company immediately in writing and send any warrant or other legal document that has been issued against him and provide all necessary information and assistance that may be requested by the Company.
- 3. The insured will not have the right to admit responsibility, negotiate or make any offer, promise or payment in relation to any event or claim without the written consent of the Company and if it wishes to the Company will have the right to undertake in the name and account of the Insured absolute direction, control and settlement of any claims and procedures at its own expense and for its own benefit, but to recover compensation from any person in relation to any cover provided by the Policy.
